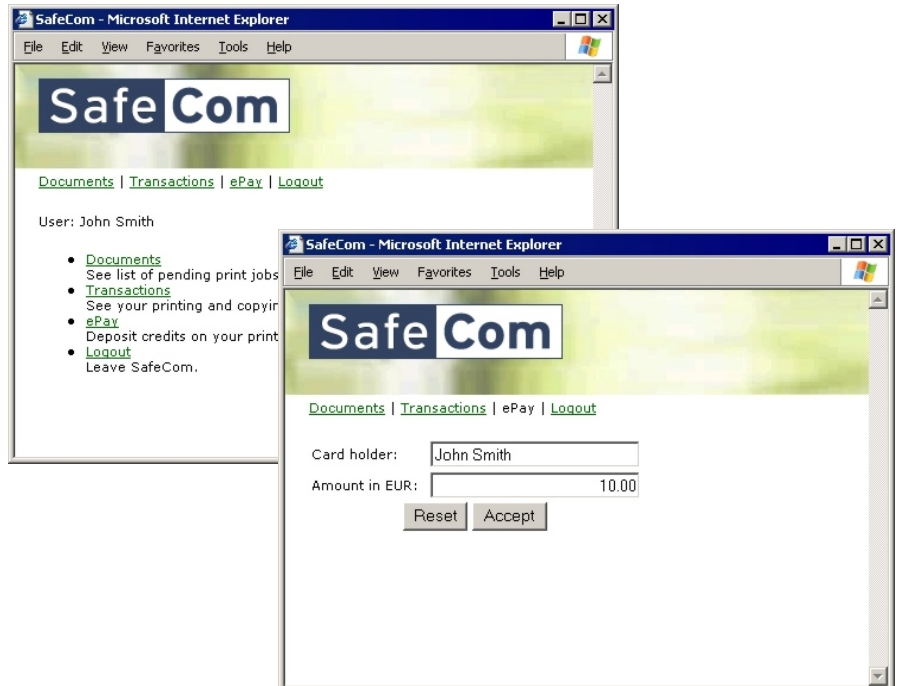

Educational institutions and libraries using a SafeCom Pay solution to offer fee-based printing and copying can use SafeCom ePay to allow users to deposit money on their SafeCom account via the Internet.

How does it work

Users opens a web browser and goes to the SafeCom ePay page to identify themselves. Next they specify the amount they wish to deposit and enters credit/debit card information. The deposited amount is transferred (encrypted) to the user's account on the SafeCom G2 server without delay. All major credit and debit cards are accepted.

Users without credit and debit card can use the SafeCom Money Loader to deposit cash money to their SafeCom account. The SafeCom Money Loader is a steel cabinet (safe) equipped with touch-screen, receipt printer, a note acceptor and a coin acceptor.



Characteristics

- Can be integrated with existing web portal and design.
- Easy-to-use interface.
- The payment-processing gateway is approved and certified by PCI, PBS and others. The gateway uses Verisign 128 bit SSL certificate.
- Accepts Visa, MasterCard, Diners, American Express, JCB and all the major credit cards. Not forgetting debit cards and local payment schemes like Switch, Laser, Electron, Dankort and more.
- One SafeCom ePay installation can service an unlimited number of users.
- Buying SafeCom ePay includes license to SafeCom G2 Web Interface where 1) Users can see their current balance and transactions on their SafeCom account and 2) Pull print users can delete and retain documents pending collection.
