SafeCom Go delivers intelligent printing solutions for the Xerox WorkCentre Pro 2xx series MFPs and the Xerox WorkCentre 56xx, 73xx and 76xx series.

SafeCom Go can authenticate users by card and/or code before they are allowed to copy, scan, fax and e-mail.

Through its flexible range of add-on functionality SafeCom Go can help organizations gain control over their print and copy costs and wastage. SafeCom Go can also enable document security on MFPs. The following add-on functionality is available:

- **SafeCom Tracking**
Monitor print and copy usage and use the recorded data for subsequent departmental invoicing.
- **SafeCom Pull Print**
Documents follow users to their choice of MFP.
- **SafeCom Rule Based Printing**
Allow print cost savings by offering management a method for enforcing policies for printing. Rules can be applied to groups of users. Requires SafeCom Tracking.
- **SafeCom Client Billing**
Allow users to associate billing codes with any print and copy job. With billing codes it is possible to get a very detailed breakdown of MFP usage and possibly recover these expenses by invoicing clients. Requires SafeCom Tracking.
- **SafeCom Pay**
Turn print and copy costs into a revenue stream by making users prepay for print and copy*. Requires SafeCom Tracking.
- **SafeCom Encryption**
Protects print data on the network. Requires SafeCom Pull Print.

SafeCom Go is compatible with external SafeCom solutions, allowing customers to offer similar functionality across a wide range of devices. Get more details on safecom.dk.

SafeCom Server

SafeCom Go includes a SafeCom Advanced Server and SafeCom Web Interface. Requirements are listed below:

Server

Windows 2003 and 2000. SafeCom License key code. Recommended: 1 GHz CPU and 1 GB RAM. 5 GB of free disk space.

Web Interface

Internet Information Service (IIS) version 6.0, 5.1 or 5.0.

Database

The free Microsoft SQL Desktop Engine (MSDE) is distributed with SafeCom. In a SafeCom Enterprise (multi server) installation the master server must run Microsoft SQL Server on either a Windows Server 2003 or a Windows 2000 Server.

Client

Windows Vista, XP, 2003, 2000, NT 4 and clients running Citrix and Windows Terminal Service. Recommended: 1 GHz CPU and 512 MB RAM. 1 GB of free disk space.

Network protocol

TCP, UDP and SNMP.

SafeCom Go Xerox

SafeCom Go integrates with the Xerox MFP's touch-screen control panel using Xerox EIP SDK. SafeCom Go gives copy control without the need of a Xerox Foreign Interface Kit.

The supplied 2-Port Ethernet switch (SafeCom Controller) allows connection of a SafeCom ID Device (card reader) and hosts the SafeCom Go software.
